

## Appendix A

### University Commons Satellite Dish Policy

In placing the satellite dish no wire post or any other fastening device can be attached to any part of the common element. The dish must be placed in the mulched bed behind the wall containing the fireplace. It should be positioned as to provide the least inconvenience to neighbors. The post can be no higher than 5 ft 6 inches (approximately) including the dish and placed no further than 5 feet from the structure. At the owners expense the poll containing the dish must be surrounded by shrubbery (approved by the Board) to camouflage the pole.

The wire to the dish must be placed underground at least eight inches and should follow as closely to the foundation as possible so as not to interfere with the mulching performed by the association. Wiring will enter the garage adjoining the 2<sup>nd</sup> bedroom. A small hole can be drilled through the siding but must be sealed with a caulking matching the color of the siding.
